Dear Fellow Grandmasters, Masters, Instructors, and Practitioners of Taekwondo;

It is with honor and great pleasure that I extend to you my personal invitation to participate in the 15th Annual Yushen Lai's Invitational TKD Championship.

This year the Yushen Lai's Invitational TKD Championship will celebrate its 15th anniversary. This tournament has always been known as one of the most well organized championships and what really makes us stand above the rest is our unique Automated Match Scheduling (AMS) system coupled with electronic scoring and padded rings.

As you all may know, events produced by my team are well known for their use of the Automated Match Scheduling (AMS) System. The system eliminates the staging area process and makes it unnecessary to leave competitors waiting there for hours. To make the tournament even better, more efficient and fair, all rings will be equipped with electronic scoring system.

The following outlines of the AMS System:

1. Most non-computerized tournaments use a manual method of matching individuals, which is often slow, confusing, and frustrating for competitors, spectators and staff.
2. Computerized matching reduces the confusion and delays by informing competitors & spectators of ring assignments, chest guard color, and approximate time of competition.
3. Competitors are checked-in and assigned matches for the tournament *prior* to arriving at the venue.
4. Greatly reduces the number of man-hours needed at the time of the event by volunteers/staff.
5. Makes sure athletes are assigned to their correct division.
6. All competitors are given "Competitor cards" prior to entering the competition floor with all personal information on each card.
 - Information includes, but is not limited to:
 - Name
 - Date of Birth / Age
 - Weight
 - Belt
 - School Name & number
 - Poomsae group number & competition ring number
 - Kyorooji bout numbers, competition ring number and color of chest guard.

We will make every attempt to make this event as fair and enjoyable for all participants as possible and it is my sincere hope that we will exceed your expectations.

On behalf of my tournament staff I would like to thank you for your continued support and we look forward to seeing you again on February 11, 2012. We wish the best of luck to those with the courage to compete and the desire to excel.

- COMPETITION RULES:** The current USAT competition rules will govern this championship.
- KYROOGI COMPETITION:** We are planning to allow black belts age 14 and above to compete first so that they may be free to coach and to allow those who might otherwise have the chance to view the exciting black belt matches.
- MANDATORY EQUIPMENT:** WTF approved white v-neck uniform only (no color trim except on black belt v-neck). All Kyoroogi competitors must wear (WTF approved): white, red or blue headgear, red and blue reversible chest protector, forearm pad, shin and instep pad, groin cup (male only, worn inside) and mouthpiece. Open Finger Gloves is optional. No Eye Glasses or Goggles allowed. Each competitor must provide his or her own equipment. Necessary equipment will be sold at the tournament site.
- COMPETITOR AWARDS:** All divisions will be maximum of 4 competitors with the exception of Black Belt ages 14 to 32.
Poomsae: One 1st, one 2nd & two 3rd place winners.
Kyroogi: One 1st, one 2nd and two 3rd place winners.
- SCHOOL AWARDS:** Most Participants Award for Schools: 1st to 10th places trophies for the schools with the most participants. (Please be sure that all Entry Forms from one school/club bear exactly the same school name).

COMPETITION RULES & REGULATIONS

The Organizing Committee recognizes that each school may have a different belt color system. Please refer to the rank & color chart below and register yourself to compete in the appropriate USAT/WTF belt color and rank.

POOMSAE: Poomsae competitors must perform only the Poomsae designated for their specific rank. Scores will be based on: proper order, beauty, grace, rhythm, accuracy, power, technique and attitude. Authorized Poomsae are those approved by the World Taekwondo Federation: Taeguek 1-8, and black belt Poomsae: Koryo, Keumgang, Taebaek etc.

KYOROOGI: The current USAT competition rules will govern this championship. The Organizing Committee may modify some rules according to the local conditions. It also reserves the right to combine or divide weight categories depending on the number of players in their respective groups. Head kicks for the juniors 12-17 (light contact only) will be allowed in addition to head kicks for senior divisions. However, if referee and judges feel an injury was due to a malicious attack (with anger or the intent to injure), the attacker will be disqualified.

Ages 11 & younger

Sparring competitors, age 11 & younger, may not make head contact at any time during a USAT competition. Any competitor, who executes a technique to the head area, will be subject to one of the following actions:

1. Any technique attempted to the head area, but does not make contact, will be given a warning by the referee (Kyong-go).
2. Any technique, which makes any contact with the head area will result in a one-point deduction by the referee (Gamjeom)
3. If the competitor cannot continue because of injury caused by contact with the head area, the attacker will be disqualified.
4. Inability to continue competition because of fright, crying or loss of will following a legal kick to the body, does not constitute grounds for disqualification of the attacker.

KYOROOGI Rules for Competitors Age 12-17 year old

1. Competitors are encouraged to attempt kicks to the head area; however absolute control must be exercised or the appropriate penalty shall be invoked.
2. The competitor who executes a successful technique (light contact without causing injury) shall be awarded the appropriate point(s).
3. The competitor who executes a kick to the head, which results in a minor injury, shall receive a one-point deduction. A minor injury is defined as an abrasion or bleeding caused by excessive contact.
4. The competitor who executes a kick to the head, which results in the inability of the opponent to continue because of injury, shall be disqualified. The center referee, with or without consultation with the tournament physician, if necessary, shall make the determination if excessive force was applied.
Note: Inability to continue because of fright, crying or loss of will, following a LEGAL kick to the head, does not constitute grounds for disqualification of the attacker.
5. Black belt competitors, age 14-17 will follow USAT Senior competition rules.
6. Age is based on the date of the tournament.
7. Duration: Age 11 & Younger: Two 60 second rounds, 30 second rest. Age 12 & Older: 90 second rounds, 30 second rest. Age 14-32 Black Belts: Three 90 second rounds, 30 second rest. (Note: All rounds stated may be changed if necessary)
8. Division: The YLI Tournament Organizing Committee reserves the right to make modifications to the divisions to provide fair and sufficient competition for all competitors. In the event that the YLIOT cannot find a suitable match, we will attempt to arrange an exhibition match. If a suitable match cannot be made, you will be awarded a gold medal for an uncontested win.

IMPORTANT: WTF Kyoroogi Scoring Rules

Point scoring: 1) Head kicks are 3 points; 2) Spinning Kicks to the Head are 4 points, 3) Turning Kicks such as back kicks & tornado kicks (natobauns) are 2 points; 3) Punches and regular kicks to the body are 1 point; 4) There is no 12-point ceiling or 7-point gap.

The major rule changes: 1) Blocking with the leg when the opponent initiates a kick will result in a warning; 2) Two feet that cross the plane of the boundary line is out, and be given a kyon-go; 3) Referee calls "Fight" after 5 seconds of inactivity and after 10 more seconds of inactivity, the athlete who has given up ground by backing up, will receive a warning.

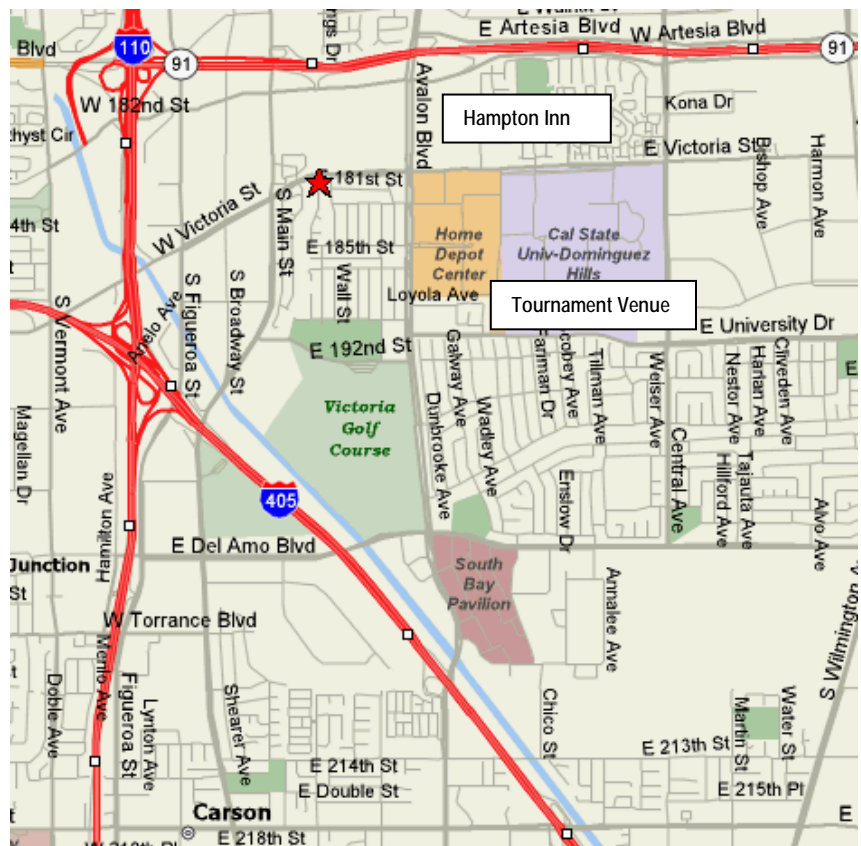
